On Monday, May 5, 2014 the City of Lincoln was awarded the Gold Risk Management Award at the 2014 Annual Convention of the Alabama League of Municipalities in Mobile, Alabama..

Approximately 740 public entities participate in one or both of the ALM sponsored insurance programs which are the Municipal Workers Compensation Fund (MWCF) and the Alabama Municipal Insurance Corporation (AMIC). The award system recognizes those members who have instituted risk management and loss control activities. Through the efforts of the City of Lincoln, employee, property and liability losses are being minimized; and most importantly employees and citizens are reaping the rewards of a safer workplace and community.

It's hard to believe that it has been over a year and a half since I took office! 2014 is off to a strong start. I certainly hope you agree. Great things are going on all around the City.

- Our annual Customer Satisfaction Survey will be available in June. The city-wide survey allows our citizens to tell us how we are performing; a useful tool to determine how the citizens of Lincoln perceive the value of specific services provided by the city and its staff.
- Our 8 million dollar ATRIP Grant funded projects are almost ready to get underway. The projects include the replacement of the Stemley Road Bridge over Choccolocco Creek and improvements to Magnolia Street and SR77. It also includes the addition of traffic signals at the SR77/I20 interchange.
- Social Media is keeping our citizens alert to all the good things and happenings in our city. We now have over 5,500 LIKES on our city pages. We launched the CITY OF LINCOLN LIBRARY page in May. If you have not "LIKED" one or all of our pages, do so today and stay in the know!
- We hope to debut our all-new city website in June. The new site will include current city news, a city calendar updated daily, downloadable forms, permits and applications to make it easier for you to do business with City Hall. Revision to Local law:

With the implementation of a new Business License ordinance effective January 1, 2014 came new license requirements. The leasing and/or rental of property such as, residential homes, commercial, mobile home parks, RV parks, apartments or warehouse/self-storage requires the property owner to have a business license.
