JOB DEFINITION

This is a skilled labor position that assists as needed in potable water and sewer maintenance activities. The employee performs various tasks, which include cleaning and maintaining facilities; mowing grass, repairing or replacing broken pipes, pumps, belts, floats; etc. Incumbent works under the supervision of the water, sewer, and street department supervisor.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Assist as needed in the operations of the water and sewer department.
- Ensure adherence to safe working practices and procedures.
- Check and maintain all equipment.
- Perform routine cleaning and maintenance.
- Maintain buildings and facilities.
- Operate mowers and power equipment.
- Perform other job related duties and special projects as required.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

- Considerable knowledge in the operation of street and sewer equipment.
- Skill in the use of tools used in general repair of mechanical equipment.
- Ability to express thoughts clearly and effectively, both verbally and in writing.
- Ability to read well and grasp the meaning of written communications.
- Ability to understand physical processes.
- Ability to use basic arithmetic.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be a graduate from an accredited high school, or hold a certificate of high school equivalency (GED).
- Must have an established interest in the operation, maintenance, and repair of wastewater treatment systems.
- Must possess a valid Alabama driver's license, commercial driver license (CDL) of the appropriate class, and a driving record suitable for insurability.
- Must be willing to travel overnight to attend continuing education courses and workshops.
- Must be physically able to perform the essential functions of the position.
- Must be willing to work non-standard hours as required.
