

**REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL, LINCOLN, ALABAMA**

January 10, 2017

The City Council of the City of Lincoln, Alabama met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall on Tuesday, January 10, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. Mayor Watson called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following answered present: Mayor Watson, Councilmembers Sadie Britt, Billy Pearson, Jennie Jones, Shelly L. Barnhart and Joey Callahan. Invocation was given by Councilmember Pearson and Mayor Watson led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Councilmember Britt made a motion to approve the minutes of December 27, 2016; second by Pearson. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Mayor Watson read Resolution 2017-11 requesting the Legislature of the State of Alabama to allow Sunday alcohol sales. Councilmember Barnhart made a motion to adopt Resolution 2017-11; second by Jones. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Councilmember Barnhart made a motion to re-appoint Judy Sanders (expiration 7/31/2018), Pat Hogge (expiration 7/31/2018), Marie Moore (expiration 7/31/2020) to the Lincoln Industrial Development Board; second by Britt. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Councilmember Callahan made a motion to appoint Chad Houze (expiration 7/31/2020), Josh Vincent (expiration 7/31/2020) and Frank Gunter (expiration 7/31/2022) to the Lincoln Industrial Development Board; second by Pearson. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.



Councilmember Britt relinquished her role on the Lincoln Planning and Zoning Commission. Councilmember Callahan made a motion to appoint Jennie Jones to the Lincoln Planning and Zoning Commission; second by Pearson. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

There being no further business to come before the Council, Pearson made a motion to adjourn; second by Britt. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.
