

REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL, LINCOLN, ALABAMA

June 13, 2017

The City Council of the City of Lincoln, Alabama met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall on Tuesday, June 13, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. Mayor Watson called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following answered present: Mayor Watson, Councilmembers Sadie Britt, Billy Pearson, Jennie Jones, Shelly L. Barnhart and Joey Callahan. Invocation was given by Councilmember Pearson and Mayor Watson led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Councilmember Britt made a motion to approve the minutes of May 9, 2017; second by Pearson. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Councilmember Barnhart made a motion to approve the minutes of May 16, 2017; second by Jones. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Mayor Watson presented Resolution 2017-22 declaring three (3) 2008 Dodge Chargers surplus and authorizing the transfer of title to the Town of Riverside. Councilmember Callahan made a motion to adopt Resolution 2017-22; second by Pearson. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Mayor Watson presented Resolution 2017-23 declaring multiple properties in Meadowview Heights a nuisance. Councilmember Jones made a motion to adopt Resolution 2017-23; second by Pearson. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Mayor Watson presented Resolution 2017-24 declaring property located at 7 College Avenue a nuisance. Councilmember Britt made a motion to adopt Resolution 2017-24; second by Jones. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Mayor Watson presented Resolution 2017-25 awarding the bid to Excellence, Inc. in the amount of \$152,537.09 for the purchase of an ambulance. Councilmember Pearson made a motion to adopt Resolution 2017-25; second by Britt. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Mayor Watson presented Resolution 2017-26 setting a special election for the sale of alcoholic beverages on Sunday on August 22, 2017. Councilmember Jones made a motion to adopt Resolution 2017-26; second by Barnhart. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.


Mayor Watson presented Ordinance 2017-12 establishing restrictions and conditions for use of land within the Lincoln Industrial Park. Councilmember Pearson made a motion to accept the first reading as having been read; second by Britt. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan. Councilmember Britt made a motion to suspend the rules that would otherwise prohibit the immediate consideration of Ordinance 2017-12; second by Pearson. The

vote was Pearson – Aye, Britt – Aye, Jones – Aye, Barnhart – Aye, Callahan – Aye and Watson – Aye. Motion passed unanimously. Councilmember Barnhart made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2017-12; second by Jones. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Councilmember Britt made a motion to appoint Alan D. Rainwater to the board of the Public Park Authority of the Cities of Lincoln and Talladega; second by Jones. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.


Mayor Watson announced City Hall will be closed July 3rd and there will not be a work session on June 20th.
