

REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL, LINCOLN, ALABAMA

August 11, 2015

The City Council of the City of Lincoln, Alabama met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall on Tuesday, August 11, 2015 at 5:00 p.m. Mayor Kitchin called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following answered present: Mayor Kitchin, Councilmembers Sadie Britt, Billy Pearson, Chris Watson, Shelly L. Barnhart and Jean B. Burk. Invocation was given by Councilmember Pearson and Councilmember Burk led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Kitchin opened the Public Hearing for the following proposed changes: (1) Re-zone parcel of owned by Thomas Wilton Hinton, Jr. and Susan Davis Hinton located at 58 Blue Eye Springs Road, Lincoln, Alabama from R-3 Multi-Family Residential to R-6 Manufactured Home Park and (2) Adopt new zoning ordinance and map. Katherine Ennis advised the new ordinance would help resolve and clarify issued the Planning Commission has had in the current ordinance. There were no other comments from the public. Mayor Kitchin closed the Public Hearing.

Councilmember Britt made a motion to approve the minutes of July 28, 2015; second by Pearson. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Watson, Barnhart and Burk.

Councilmember Watson made a motion to amend the agenda to place Communication from Audience before Ordinances/Resolutions; second by Pearson. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Watson, Barnhart and Burk.

Mayor Kitchin presented Ordinance 2015-10 to re-zone a parcel of land owned by Thomas Wilton Hinton, Jr. and Susan Davis Hinton located at 58 Blue Eye Springs Road, Lincoln, Alabama from R-3 Multi-Family Residential to R-6 Manufactured Home Park. Councilmember Pearson made a motion to accept the first reading as having been read; second by Britt. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Watson, Barnhart and Burk. Councilmember Britt made a motion to suspend the rules that would otherwise prohibit the immediate consideration of Ordinance 2015-10; second by Watson. The vote was Pearson – Aye, Britt – Aye, Watson – Aye, Barnhart – Aye, Burk – Aye and Mayor Kitchin – Aye. Motion passed unanimously. Councilmember Watson made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2015-10; second by Barnhart. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Watson, Barnhart and Burk.

Mayor Kitchin presented Ordinance 2015-11 which is a new zoning ordinance and zoning map. Councilmember Pearson made a motion to accept the first reading as having been read; second by Watson. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Watson and Burk. Nay: Barnhart.

Councilmember Britt made a motion to authorize the Mayor to execute a Working Agreement with Talladega County and its Board of Registrars to promote the best and most efficient methods for municipal elections within the county and to establish responsibilities and duties concerning municipal elections relative to the identification program of registered voters under


Section 11-46-4 of the Code of Alabama; second by Pearson. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Watson, Barnhart and Burk.

There being no further business to come before the Council, Pearson made a motion to adjourn; second by Burk. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Watson, Barnhart and Burk.
