

REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL, LINCOLN, ALABAMA

November 8, 2016

The City Council of the City of Lincoln, Alabama met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall on Tuesday, November 8, 2016 at 5:00 p.m. Mayor Watson called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following answered present: Mayor Watson, Councilmembers Sadie Britt, Billy Pearson, Jennie Jones, Shelly L. Barnhart and Joey Callahan. Invocation was given by Councilmember Pearson and Councilmember Pearson led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Councilmember Britt made a motion to approve the minutes of October 25, 2016; second by Pearson. The vote was Yeas: Britt, Pearson, Jones and Callahan; Abstain – Barnhart.

Mayor Watson presented Resolution 2017-07 granting a one-time salary increase. Councilmember Barnhart made a motion to adopt Resolution 2017-07; second by Pearson. The vote was Yeas: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Councilmember Jones made a motion to appoint Travis Mattox as Street Department Supervisor; second by Callahan. The vote was Yeas: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Councilmember Jones made a motion to rescind the action taken on October 25, 2016 approving the Networkfleet Pricing Proposal with Verizon in the amount of \$17,642.03; second by Callahan. The vote was Yeas: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Councilmember Britt made a motion to approve continuing the use of the law firm of Thornton, Carpenter, O'Brien, Lawrence and Sims as the city attorney; second by Pearson. The vote was Yeas: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Mayor Watson appointed the following Department Liaisons: Sadie Britt – Library, Billy Pearson – Public Works, Jennie Jones – Fire Department, Shelly L. Barnhart – Parks & Recreation and Joey Callahan – Police Department.

Mayor Watson advised the time of the Work Sessions on the 3rd Tuesday of the month would be changed from 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. There will not be a work session on 11/15/2016 due to the NLC meeting.

There being no further business to come before the Council, Pearson made a motion to adjourn; second by Barnhart. The vote was Yeas: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.
