

REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL, LINCOLN, ALABAMA

June 26, 2018

The City Council of the City of Lincoln, Alabama met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall on Tuesday, June 26, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. Councilmember Barnhart called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following answered present: Councilmembers Pearson, Jennie Jones, Shelly L. Barnhart and Joey Callahan. Mayor Watson and Councilmember Sadie Britt were absent. Councilmember Jones took minutes in the clerk's absence. Invocation was given by Councilmember Pearson and Councilmember Barnhart led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Councilmember Barnhart opened the Public Hearing regarding nuisances on the following properties: 20 Guy Drive, 625 Oxford Road, 75 Camerons Way and 1011 Magnolia Street. Jason Evans spoke regarding the property located at 625 Oxford Road. He advised the Council of the following: (1) The property was his mother's who had recently passed away; (2) The garbage has been placed in an on-site dumpster and is scheduled to be removed by Thursday; and (3) The abandoned vehicle is not his and is scheduled to be removed by Saturday. Mr. David Cole and Mr. Edward Taylor spoke regarding sewer leaks and the Council informed them the hearing was for nuisance properties. Adam Thrasher, Code Enforcement Officer, reported the following: (1) In his opinion 20 Guy Drive has satisfied the complaints; (2) 625 Oxford Road has done as Mr. Evans stated; (3) 75 Camerons Way has the abandoned car and no one has contacted his office and (4) 1011 Magnolia Street's owner has removed 2 abandoned cars but has some debris remaining to be removed. There were no further comments from the public and Councilmember Barnhart closed the Public Hearing.

Councilmember Pearson made a motion to approve the minutes of June 12, 2018; second by Callahan. The vote was Ayes: Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Councilmember Pearson made a motion to approve the minutes of June 19, 2018; second by Jones. The vote was Ayes: Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Councilmember Jones made a motion to extend the deadline for compliance regarding 625 Oxford Road to July 6, 2018; second by Pearson. The vote was Ayes: Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Councilmember Callahan made a motion to adopt Resolution 2018-37 abating the property at 75 Camerons Way; second by Jones. The vote was Ayes: Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Councilmember Pearson made a motion to extend the deadline for compliance regarding 1011 Magnolia Street to July 6, 2018; second by Callahan. The vote was Ayes: Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.


Councilmember Barnhart presented Ordinance 2018-11 establishing curbside brush and waste pickup throughout the city. Councilmember Pearson made a motion to accept the first reading as having been read; second by Jones. The vote was Ayes: Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan. Councilmember Pearson made a motion to suspend the rules that would otherwise prohibit the immediate consideration of Ordinance 2018-11; second by Callahan. The vote was Pearson – Aye, Jones – Aye, Barnhart – Aye and Callahan – Aye. Motion passed unanimously. Councilmember Callahan made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2018-11; second by Pearson. The vote was Ayes: Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Councilmember Callahan made a motion to appoint Shelly L. Barnhart as Chairman Pro Tempore for the period of July, 2018 – April, 2019; second by Jones. The vote was Ayes: Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Councilmember Pearson made a motion to approve the installation of the following street lights: one on Lakeshore Drive, two on Creekview Lane, one at the intersection of Eureka Road and Blue River Drive and one in the alley behind Two Friends Florist; second by Jones. The vote was Ayes: Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Councilmember Callahan made a motion to approve the sale of the trees on the city property located on Stine Lane; second by Pearson. The vote was Ayes: Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

There being no further business to come before the Council, Pearson made a motion to adjourn; second by Callahan. The vote was Ayes: Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.
