

REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL, LINCOLN, ALABAMA

October 14, 2014

The City Council of the City of Lincoln, Alabama met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall on Tuesday, October 14, 2014 at 5:00 p.m. Mayor Kitchin called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following answered present: Mayor Kitchin, Councilmembers Billy Pearson, Sadie Britt, Gwen Barber, Shelly L. Barnhart and Jean B. Burk. Invocation was given by Councilmember Pearson and Councilmember Burk led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Councilmember Pearson made a motion to approve the minutes of September 23, 2014; second by Burk. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Barber, Barnhart and Burk.

Councilmember Pearson made a motion to approve a 040 – Retail Beer (On or Off Premises) for Tian Le Chen d/b/a China Star III located at 131 Magnolia Street South, Lincoln, Alabama; second by Britt. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Barber, Barnhart and Burk.

Councilmember Pearson made a motion to approve a 050 – Retail Beer (Off Premises Only) and 070 – Retail Table Wine (Off Premises Only) for Gary L. Smith d/b/a A1 Pit Stop located at 5955 Speedway Blvd, Eastaboga, Alabama; second by Barnhart. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Barber, Barnhart and Burk.

Councilmember Britt made a motion to let bids for Sand Filter Rehabilitation and Chemical Feed Improvements to the Lincoln Wastewater Treatment Plant; second by Burk. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Barber, Barnhart and Burk.

Councilmember Britt made a motion to table a 010 – Lounge Retail Liquor – Class I for Club Freeway, Inc. d/b/a Club Freeway located at 1960 McCaig Road, Lincoln, Alabama pending the report from the Police Department; second by Burk. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Barber, Barnhart and Burk.


