

REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL, LINCOLN, ALABAMA

December 10, 2013

The City Council of the City of Lincoln, Alabama met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall on Tuesday, December 10, 2013 at 5:00 p.m. Mayor Kitchin called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following answered present: Mayor Kitchin, Councilmembers Billy Pearson, Sadie Britt, Gwen Barber, H. H. Kuykendall, Jr. and Jean B. Burk. Invocation was given by Councilmember Pearson and Councilmember Kuykendall led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Kitchin read a proclamation recognizing Larry Ward for his service as Municipal Judge for the city.

Councilmember Britt made a motion to approve the minutes of November 26, 2013; second by Pearson. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Barber, Kuykendall and Burk.

Mayor Kitchin presented Resolution 2014-06 requesting a local bill be introduced in the 2014 regular session to allow a referendum to allow Sunday alcohol sales. Councilmember Kuykendall made a motion to adopt Resolution 2014-06; second by Britt. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Barber, Kuykendall and Burk.

Mayor Kitchin presented Ordinance 2014-01 establishing business license rates. Councilmember Kuykendall made a motion to accept the first reading as having been read; second by Pearson. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Barber, Kuykendall and Burk. Councilmember Britt made a motion to suspend the rules that would otherwise prohibit the immediate consideration of Ordinance 2014-01; second by Kuykendall. The vote was Pearson – Aye, Britt – Aye, Barber – Aye, Kuykendall – Aye, Burk – Aye and Mayor Kitchin – Aye. Motion passed unanimously. Councilmember Pearson made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2014-01; second by Britt. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Barber, Kuykendall and Burk.

Councilmember Kuykendall made a motion to appoint William E. Hollingsworth, IV as the City Prosecutor for a term of 18 months beginning December, 2013; second by Burk. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Barber, Kuykendall and Burk.

Councilmember Pearson made a motion to appoint George Sims as the City Public Defender for a term of 18 months beginning December, 2013; second by Burk. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Barber, Kuykendall and Burk.


