

CALLED MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL, LINCOLN, ALABAMA

August 29, 2017

The City Council of the City of Lincoln, Alabama met for a called meeting in the Council Chambers at City Hall on Tuesday, August 29, 2017 at noon. Mayor Watson called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following answered present: Mayor Watson, Councilmembers Sadie Britt, Billy Pearson, Jennie Jones and Joey Callahan. Councilmember Shelly L. Barnhart was absent.

Mayor Watson presented Resolution 2017-35 canvassing the special election results. Councilmember Pearson made a motion to adopt Resolution 2017-35; second by Britt. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones and Callahan.

Mayor Watson presented Ordinance 2017-17 authorizing the sale of certain alcoholic beverages in the municipality on Sundays under certain conditions. Councilmember Pearson made a motion to accept the first reading as having been read; second by Jones. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones and Callahan. Councilmember Britt made a motion to suspend the rules that would otherwise prohibit the immediate consideration of Ordinance 2017-17; second by Callahan. The vote was Pearson – Aye, Britt – Aye, Jones – Aye, Callahan – Aye and Mayor Watson – Aye. Motion passed unanimously. Councilmember Pearson made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2017-17; second by Britt. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones and Callahan.

Councilmember Pearson made a motion to authorize the Mayor to execute a Proposal for Services with Gonzalez – Strength & Associates, Inc. for the Norfolk Southern – Stines Lane Railroad Crossing Improvements in the amount of \$12,500; second by Britt. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones and Callahan.

There being no further business to come before the Council, Pearson made a motion to adjourn; second by Jones. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones and Callahan.
