

**CALLED MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL, LINCOLN, ALABAMA**

November 2, 2017

The City Council of the City of Lincoln, Alabama met for a called meeting in the Council Chambers at City Hall on Thursday, November 2, 2017 at noon. Mayor Watson called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following answered present: Mayor Watson, Councilmembers Sadie Britt, Billy Pearson, Shelly L. Barnhart and Joey Callahan. Councilmember Jennie Jones was absent.

Mayor Watson presented Ordinance 2018-01 annexing property owned by Legacy Cabinets LLC located on Legacy Boulevard into the city limits. Councilmember Barnhart made a motion to accept the first reading as having been read; second by Pearson. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Barnhart and Callahan. Councilmember Britt made a motion to suspend the rules that would otherwise prohibit the immediate consideration of Ordinance 2018-01; second by Callahan. The vote was Pearson – Aye, Britt – Aye, Barnhart – Aye, Callahan – Aye and Mayor Watson – Aye. Motion passed unanimously. Councilmember Pearson made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2018-01; second by Britt. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Barnhart and Callahan.


Mayor Watson presented Resolution 2018-03 granting a one-time salary increase to employees. Councilmember Callahan made a motion to adopt Resolution 2018-03; second by Pearson. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Barnhart and Callahan.

Mayor Watson presented Resolution 2018-04 requesting the legislature to annex a portion of Interstate 20 in order to connect a detached parcel to the main body of the city. Councilmember Pearson made a motion to adopt Resolution 2018-04; second by Britt. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Barnhart and Callahan.

There being no further business to come before the Council, Pearson made a motion to adjourn; second by Callahan. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Barnhart and Callahan.
