

REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL, LINCOLN, ALABAMA

November 28, 2017

The City Council of the City of Lincoln, Alabama met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall on Tuesday, November 29, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. Mayor Watson called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following answered present: Mayor Watson, Councilmembers Sadie Britt, Billy Pearson, Jennie Jones, Shelly L. Barnhart and Joey Callahan. Invocation was given by Councilmember Pearson and Mayor Watson led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Councilmember Britt made a motion to approve the minutes of October 24, 2017; second by Barnhart. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Councilmember Pearson made a motion to approve the minutes of November 2, 2017; second by Britt. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Mayor Watson presented Resolution 2018-05 declaring the Laird property located at Lot 32 in Taylors Farm a nuisance. Councilmember Britt made a motion to adopt Resolution 2018-05; second by Barnhart. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Mayor Watson presented Resolution 2018-06 declaring the McKenzie property located at Lot 1 on Magnolia Street a nuisance. Councilmember Pearson made a motion to adopt Resolution 2018-06; second by Britt. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Mayor Watson presented Resolution 2018-07 declaring the Gordy property located on Blue Eye Springs Road a nuisance. Councilmember Barnhart made a motion to adopt Resolution 2018-07; second by Pearson. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Mayor Watson presented Resolution 2018-08 declaring the Graaf property located on Woodrow Street a nuisance. Councilmember Pearson made a motion to adopt Resolution 2018-08; second by Britt. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Mayor Watson presented Resolution 2018-09 declaring the Reaves property on College Avenue a nuisance. Councilmember Britt made a motion to adopt Resolution 2018-09; second by Barnhart. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Mayor Watson presented Resolution 2018-10 declaring the Woodard properties on Blue Eye Springs Road a nuisance. Councilmember Pearson made a motion to adopt Resolution 2018-10; second by Britt. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Councilmember Callahan made a motion to approve a 011 – Lounge Retail Liquor – Class II (Package) for Mazruqa, Inc. d/b/a 77 Liquor located at 76022 Hwy 77 Ste A, Lincoln, AL 35096; second by Barnhart. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Councilmember Pearson made a motion to table the approval of a 050 – Retail Beer (Off Premises Only) for Wadee Corporation d/b/a Exxon QV located at 75639 AL Hwy 77, Lincoln, AL 35096; second by Britt. After discussion the vote was Pearson – Aye, Britt – Aye, Jones – Nay, Barnhart – Nay and Callahan – Nay. Motion to table failed. Councilmember Callahan made a motion to approve a 050 – Retail Beer (Off Premises Only) for Wadee Corporation d/b/a Exxon QV located at 75639 AL Hwy 77, Lincoln, AL 35096; second by Barnhart. The vote was Pearson – Nay, Britt – Nay, Jones – Aye, Barnhart – Aye and Callahan – Aye. Motion approved. Councilmember Jones requested the records reflect she voted in favor of due to the fact the business owner is now in compliance.

Councilmember Barnhart made a motion to approve a 070 – Retail Table Wine (Off Premises Only) for Wadee Corporation d/b/a Exxon QV located at 75639 AL Hwy 77, Lincoln, AL 35096; second by Callahan. The vote was Pearson – Nay, Britt – Nay, Jones – Aye, Barnhart – Aye and Callahan – Aye. Motion approved.

At 6:25 p.m. Councilmember Britt made a motion to go into executive session to discuss a real estate transaction and to resume the meeting in approximately ten (10) minutes; second by Pearson. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan. Mayor Watson reconvened the meeting at 6:50 p.m.

After discussion, Mayor Watson advised the work session on December 19th needs to be rescheduled. Councilmembers are to contact the city clerk to establish a new meeting time for the work session.

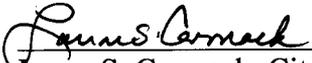
