

REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL, LINCOLN, ALABAMA

August 28, 2018

The City Council of the City of Lincoln, Alabama met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall on Tuesday, August 28, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. Mayor Watson called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following answered present: Councilmembers Sadie Britt, Billy Pearson, Jennie Jones and Joey Callahan. Councilmember Barnhart was absent. Councilmember Britt took minutes in the clerk's absence. Invocation was given by Councilmember Pearson and Mayor Watson led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Councilmember Britt made a motion to approve the minutes of August 14, 2018; second by Pearson. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones and Callahan.

Councilmember Pearson made a motion to approve the minutes of August 21, 2018; second by Britt. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones and Callahan.

Mayor Watson presented Ordinance 2018-12 declaring the property located at 286 Magnolia Street as surplus. Councilmember Pearson made a motion to accept the first reading as having been read; second by Britt. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones and Callahan. Councilmember Callahan made a motion to suspend the rules that would prohibit the immediate consideration of Ordinance 2018-12; second by Jones. The vote was Pearson – Aye, Britt – Aye, Jones – Aye, Callahan – Aye and Mayor Watson – Aye. Motion passed unanimously. Councilmember Britt made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2018-12; second by Jones. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones and Callahan.

Mayor Watson presented Resolution 2018-49 granting a tax abatement to Lohr North America, LLC. Councilmember Pearson made a motion to adopt Resolution 2018-49; second by Callahan. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones and Callahan.

Mayor Watson presented Resolution 2018-50 assessing the cost of weed abatement against the Manning property located at 145 Whispering Oaks. Councilmember Britt made a motion to adopt Resolution 2018-50; second by Jones. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones and Callahan.

Councilmember Pearson made a motion to authorize the Mayor to execute a Mutual Aid Agreement between Lincoln Fire/Rescue and Regional Paramedical Services, Inc. (RPS); second by Jones. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones and Callahan.

There being no further business to come before the Council, Pearson made a motion to adjourn; second by Jones. The vote was Ayes: Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.
