The City Council of the City of Lincoln, Alabama met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall on Tuesday, September 11, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. Mayor Watson called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following answered present: Mayor Watson, Councilmembers Sadie Britt, Billy Pearson, Jennie Jones, Shelly L. Barnhart and Joey Callahan. Invocation was given by Councilmember Pearson and Mayor Watson led the Pledge of Allegiance.


