

## **REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL, LINCOLN, ALABAMA**

September 25, 2018

The City Council of the City of Lincoln, Alabama met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall on Tuesday, September 25, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. Mayor Watson called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following answered present: Mayor Watson, Councilmembers Sadie Britt, Billy Pearson, Jennie Jones, Shelly L. Barnhart and Joey Callahan. Invocation was given by Councilmember Pearson and Mayor Watson led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Councilmember Britt made a motion to approve the minutes of September 11, 2018; second by Pearson. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Councilmember Jones made a motion to approve the minutes of September 18, 2018; second by Callahan. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Mayor Watson presented Ordinance 2018-13 to erect stop signs at the intersection of Jones Street and 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue W. Councilmember Jones made a motion to accept the first reading as having been read; second by Pearson. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan. Councilmember Britt made a motion to suspend the rules that would otherwise prohibit the immediate consideration of Ordinance 2018-13; second by Callahan. The vote was Pearson – Aye, Britt – Aye, Jones – Aye, Barnhart – Aye, Callahan – Aye and Mayor Watson – Aye. Motion passed unanimously. Councilmember Barnhart made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2018-13; second by Britt. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Mayor Watson presented Resolution 2018-51 assessing the cost of nuisance abatement against the Stuart property located at 119 – 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue. Councilmember Jones made a motion to adopt Resolution 2018-51; second by Callahan. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Mayor Watson presented Resolution 2018-52 abating the R. Watson property located on Magnolia Street. Councilmember Barnhart made a motion to adopt Resolution 2018-52; second by Jones. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Mayor Watson presented Resolution 2018-53 finding the R. Watson property located on Magnolia Street unsafe. Councilmember Jones made a motion to adopt Resolution 2018-53; second by Pearson. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Councilmember Barnhart made a motion to authorize the Mayor to execute an Interpreter Service Agreement with AIDB; second by Pearson. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

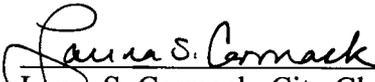
