

REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL, LINCOLN, ALABAMA

December 11, 2018

The City Council of the City of Lincoln, Alabama met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall on Tuesday, December 11, 2018 at 5:00 p.m. Mayor Watson called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following answered present: Mayor Watson, Councilmembers Sadie Britt, Billy Pearson, Jennie Jones, Shelly L. Barnhart and Joey Callahan. Invocation was given by Councilmember Pearson and Mayor Watson led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Councilmember Jones made a motion to approve the minutes of November 27, 2018; second by Barnhart. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Mayor Watson presented Resolution 2019-22 authorizing the submission of a Land and Water Conservation application through the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs. Councilmember Barnhart made a motion to adopt Resolution 2019-22; second by Callahan. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.


Mayor Watson presented Resolution 2019-23 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Coach Safely Foundation. Councilmember Barnhart made a motion to adopt Resolution 2019-23; second by Britt. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Councilmember Callahan made a motion to approve three street lights on Joe Street, two on Pine Circle and one at Eureka Road and Sullivan Lane; second by Barnhart. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

There being no further business to come before the Council, Pearson made a motion to adjourn; second by Jones. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.
