

REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL, LINCOLN, ALABAMA

March 26, 2019

The City Council of the City of Lincoln, Alabama met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall on Tuesday, March 26, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. Mayor Watson called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following answered present: Mayor Watson, Councilmembers Sadie Britt, Billy Pearson, Jennie Jones, Shelly L. Barnhart and Joey Callahan. Invocation was given by Councilmember Pearson and Mayor Watson led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Councilmember Britt made a motion to approve the minutes of February 26, 2019; second by Jones. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Mayor Watson presented Ordinance 2019-04 declaring real property surplus and authorizing the conveyance of said property. The property is located on Jackson Trace Road and consists of 5.54 acres. Councilmember Pearson made a motion to accept the first reading as having been read; second by Britt. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan. Councilmember Britt made a motion to suspend the rules that would otherwise prohibit the immediate consideration of Ordinance 2019-04; second by Pearson. The vote was Pearson – Aye, Britt – Aye, Jones – Aye, Barnhart – Aye, Callahan – Aye and Watson – Aye. Motion passed unanimously. Councilmember Pearson made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2019-04; second by Jones. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Mayor Watson presented Resolution 2019-32 approving the annual MWPP report. Councilmember Pearson made a motion to adopt Resolution 2019-32; second by Barnhart. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Councilmember Callahan made a motion to remove Resolution 2019-09 from the table; second by Pearson. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan. After discussion, Councilmember Callahan made a motion to adopt Resolution 2019-09 assessing the cost of nuisance abatement against the Watson property located on Magnolia Street; second by Jones. The vote was Pearson – Nay, Britt – Abstain, Jones – Nay, Barnhart – Nay and Callahan – Nay. Motion failed.

Councilmember Callahan made a motion to approve a 050 – Retail Beer (Off Premises Only) and a 070 – Retail Table Wine (Off Premises Only) for ALIS Inc d/b/a Marathon Food Mart located at 75837 AL Hwy 77, Lincoln, Alabama; second by Barnhart. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Councilmember Barnhart made a motion to authorize the Mayor to obtain an appraisal on the property located at 282 Creekview Lane, Lincoln, Alabama for a potential sale; second by Jones. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Councilmember Callahan made a motion to approve Change Order No. 1 in the amount of \$5,550.00 for Burford's Construction on the U.S. Hwy 78 (SR-4) Streetscape, Sidewalks & Roadway Lighting project; second by Pearson. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

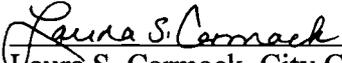
Councilmember Barnhart made a motion to authorize the Mayor to execute the proposal from Gonzalez – Strength & Associates, Inc. for the Moseley Park Renovations; second by Jones. After discussion, Councilmember Jones withdrew her second to the motion. Motion dies for lack of second.

There being no further business to come before the Council, Pearson made a motion to adjourn; second by Callahan. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.
