

REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL, LINCOLN, ALABAMA

July 23, 2019

The City Council of the City of Lincoln, Alabama met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall on Tuesday, July 23, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. Mayor Watson called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following answered present: Mayor Watson, Councilmembers Sadie Britt, Billy Pearson, Jennie Jones, Shelly L. Barnhart and Joey Callahan. Invocation was given by Councilmember Pearson and Mayor Watson led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Councilmember Britt made a motion to approve the minutes of July 9, 2019; second by Jones. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Councilmember Barnhart made a motion to approve the minutes of July 16, 2019; second by Callahan. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Councilmember Pearson made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2019-05 re-zoning a portion Gene S. Sharp property located at 567 Patton Chapel Road from RE Residential Estate to RS-2 Residential Single Family; second by Barnhart. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones and Barnhart; Abstain – Callahan.

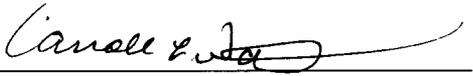
Mayor Watson presented Ordinance 2019-06 establishing fees for Haz-Mat Services. Councilmember Callahan made a motion to accept the first reading as having been read; second by Jones. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan. Councilmember Britt made a motion to suspend the rules that would otherwise prohibit the immediate consideration of Ordinance 2019-06; second by Pearson. The vote was Pearson – Aye, Britt – Aye, Jones – Aye, Barnhart – Aye, Callahan – Aye and Mayor Watson – Aye. Motion passed unanimously. Councilmember Jones made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2019-06; second by Barnhart. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Mayor Watson presented Ordinance 2019-07 establishing a schedule of charges for equipment usage to be assessed for the abatement of nuisances. Councilmember Jones made a motion to accept the first reading as having been read; second by Britt. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan. Councilmember Pearson made a motion to suspend the rules that would otherwise prohibit the immediate consideration of Ordinance 2019-07; second by Britt. The vote was Pearson – Aye, Britt – Aye, Jones – Aye, Barnhart – Aye, Callahan – Aye and Mayor Watson – Aye. Motion passed unanimously. Councilmember Barnhart made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2019-07; second by Jones. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Councilmember Callahan made a motion to authorize the Mayor to execute the Settlement Agreement and Release of All Claims with Midwest Sporting Supplies – Southeast, LLC; second by Britt. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

Councilmember Pearson made a motion to authorize the Mayor to execute the application for Industrial Access funds for the remainder of the road in the Lincoln Industrial Park; second by Jones. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.

There being no further business to come before the Council, Pearson made a motion to adjourn; second by Jones. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Jones, Barnhart and Callahan.
