

REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL, LINCOLN, ALABAMA

April 22, 2014

The City Council of the City of Lincoln, Alabama met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall on Tuesday, April 22, 2014 at 5:00 p.m. Mayor Kitchin called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following answered present: Mayor Kitchin, Councilmembers Billy Pearson, Sadie Britt, Gwen Barber, H. H. Kuykendall, Jr. and Jean B. Burk. Invocation was given by Councilmember Pearson and Councilmember Kuykendall led the Pledge of Allegiance.


Councilmember Barber made a motion to approve the minutes of April 8, 2014; second by Britt. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Barber, Kuykendall and Burk.

Councilmember Britt made a motion to approve the minutes of April 15, 2014; second by Burk. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Barber, and Burk.

Mayor Kitchin presented Resolution 2014-14 authorizing the city to apply for a TAP Grant through ALDOT for sidewalk and streetscape improvements. Councilmember Kuykendall made a motion to adopt Resolution 2014-14; second by Barber. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Barber, Kuykendall and Burk.


Councilmember Kuykendall made a motion to authorize the Mayor to execute an agreement with East Alabama Regional Planning and Development Commission for creating a GIS of the city's water and sewer systems and annexation mapping to the city since 1995 in an amount up to \$10,000; second by Pearson. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Barber, Kuykendall and Burk.

There being no further business to come before the Council, Kuykendall made a motion to adjourn; second by Burk. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson, Barber, Kuykendall and Burk.
