

REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL, LINCOLN, ALABAMA

July 8, 2014

The City Council of the City of Lincoln, Alabama met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall on Tuesday, July 8, 2014 at 5:00 p.m. Mayor Kitchin called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following answered present: Mayor Kitchin, Councilmembers Billy Pearson, Sadie Britt and Gwen Barber. Councilmember Jean B. Burk was absent. Invocation was given by Councilmember Pearson and Councilmember Barber led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Councilmember Britt made a motion to approve the minutes of June 24, 2014; second by Barber. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson and Barber.


Mayor Kitchin acknowledged the council seat in Ward 4 is vacant due to the passing of Councilmember Kuykendall.

Mayor Kitchin presented Ordinance 2014-18 designating certain described land as an industrial park and establishing restrictions and conditions for the use of land contained within the Lincoln Industrial Park. Councilmember Pearson made a motion to accept the first reading as having been read; second by Britt. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson and Barber. Councilmember Britt made a motion to suspend the rules that would otherwise prohibit the immediate consideration of Ordinance 2014-18; second by Barber. The vote was Pearson – Aye, Britt – Aye, Barber – Aye and Mayor Kitchin – Aye. Motion passed unanimously. Councilmember Pearson made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2014-18; second by Britt. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson and Barber.

Councilmember Pearson made a motion to appoint Jon Cullimore to the board of the Public Park Authority of the Cities of Lincoln and Talladega; second by Britt. The vote was Ayes: Britt, Pearson and Barber.


